Thus the somewhat flat, simplified style of crafts as well as arts trends, which continue to grab our creative imaginations today.

William Morris made his very first design, 'Trellis', in 1862. His concepts, which featured English vegetation as well as animals and colours, gained popularity in the 1890s and 1880s, and also a massive variety are still available today by means of Type Public library.
