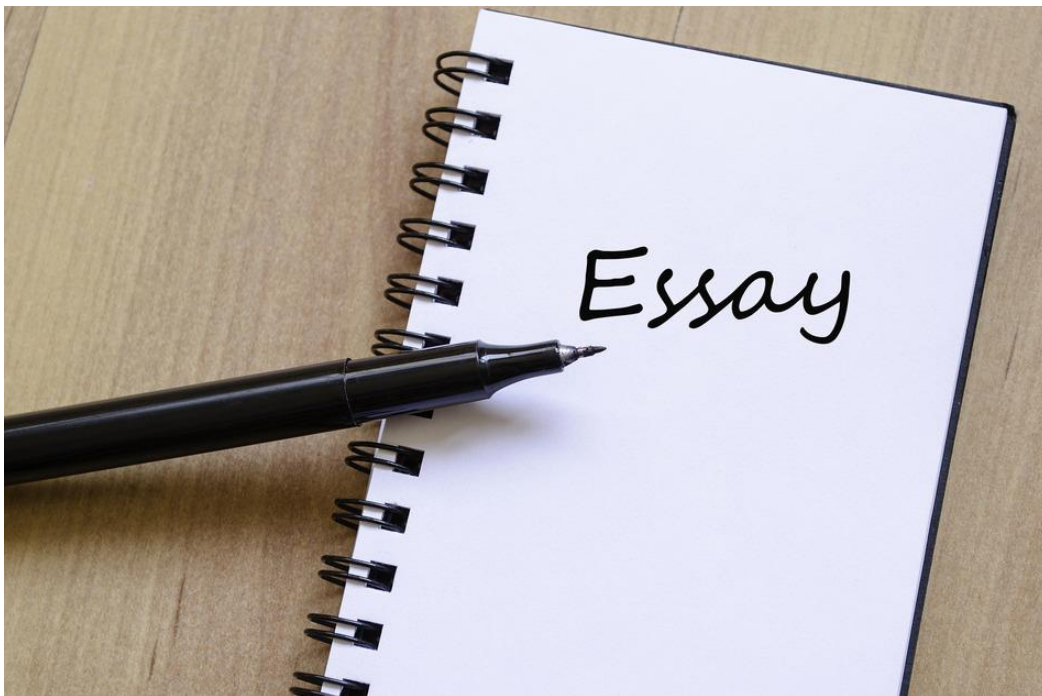


How To Write A Reflection Essay- Guide 2021

In my opinion, the best way to write a reflection essay is to select one or two topics you are most interested in writing about. You could be encouraged by your tutor and/or by your fellow students. Another way is to pick up something that has happened yesterday, last week or even longer ago in order to remember what it was like back then. You can also get [dissertation writing services](#). It doesn't matter which method you choose, as long as it works and you will get a topic that can make an interesting read that is easily understood by the reader (in this case it is probably going to be your Professor).

The next step would be research into the issue of choice. When I have deliberated on my own personal experience for my essay I had decided very early on that I would focus on my hobby. This is often a good idea because it causes you to understand and appreciate something that you love doing. You might be surprised how your understanding can grow at the same time as you are writing the piece of work. After all, learning should never stop!



One of the main things that help me with writing a reflection essay is taking care not to write everything in chronological order. Without any proper structure your readers will probably feel like watching a movie without direction or purpose for that matter... On the other hand, if there is no logical connection between events, it also does not make sense to inform them one by one. Nevertheless, when we have decided on what exactly should go into our essay, we should use some logic and order in the stories we tell.

But before I start writing, I should talk about how to create a decent outline for a reflection essay... There are several important tips and things that you should remember when it comes to composing an outline. The first one is trying to write down all the most important events from your everyday life as well as some very meaningful moments. Second step would be choosing what will come first, second, third etc. Having this done, we can move on to actual writing of our essay!

One thing you should definitely bear in mind whilst writing your reflective essay is the fact that your readers don't necessarily need every single detail you could possibly come up with. The best way to achieve this is by taking care of the dialogue between you and your readers. You should always try and keep them interested!

It is just one of those nice things that can make your writing look even better. And if you are going to include pictures into your piece of work you could also think about mixing several different fonts while doing so. Not only does this look interesting but it makes your text easier on the eye (don't overdo it though). Your final step would be proofreading . This might take quite a bit of time but it is worth doing regardless because I often notice mistakes in my writing after a couple of days, especially when they are related to basic grammar errors.
