

Paraphrase Without Plagiarizing- Guide 2021

Paraphrasing is a way to demonstrate understanding of information by rewriting sentences without changing the meaning. You can get [dissertation writing services](#) to help you in this regard. In academic writing, it is advisable that you paraphrase rather than quote text as this will show your originality and comprehension.

There are five steps that you can consider when paraphrasing.

1. Understand the passage by reading it a number of times
2. Note down the important steps
3. Write your own version of the passage
4. Compare your text to the original passage
5. Cite the source from where you have found the information



I'm sure you are wondering how to rephrase a large amount of text for your essay. But don't worry, we have all been there before and it can seem impossible at first glance! If this is something that has caught you off guard or if the thought of having to rewrite an entire paragraph seems daunting, I recommend writing down any questions in-line with what was said so far then moving onto another section. It will help break up the task into smaller chunks which may be more manageable when facing such a difficult assignment like paraphrasing some content found online for use in essays as well as other written assignments. If you are looking for ways to know how to paraphrase text the right way. Following are the four importance tricks to help you do so:

Start your first sentence in a different way from the original text. Try to incorporate the key points in a completely different order.

Use synonyms as much as possible. These are the words with the same meaning.

Change the sentence structure entirely. For example, if the original text is in the active voice, change it to passive.

Although paraphrasing results in the same word count as in the original passage, you can still change the number of sentences to make the text look more different and original.

When paraphrasing a text, it is important to avoid plagiarism. To make sure you have clearly done so, run your draft through the Plagiarism Checker before submitting it as final copy.
