

The Process Of Car Importation In Bangladesh

Japan is a major source of second-hand Japanese vehicles for import into Bangladesh.

Bangladesh expresses for a car market prior to buying an automobile because the market offers an extensive range of motors you can choose at a reasonable price. In good condition, used Japanese vehicles are considered to be top motor cars. They are sturdy and reliable and this is the reason they are so well-liked in Bangladesh's automobile market. Around 80% of vehicles that are sold in Bangladesh are Japan imported. Car Import to Bangladesh must be right-hand drive because the vehicles travel on the left-hand side of the road.

Conditions for Import

Importation of used vehicles from Bangladesh including jeeps micro-buses and many more vehicles is only permitted under the following conditions:

The import of vehicles is permitted only from the country of origin. the importation of vehicles is not permitted by any other third party.

The age of the vehicle should not be more than four years old.

The right-hand drive must be used to connect the car

The document issued by JAAI should include the model number, age, and the chassis number of the car. This certificate should be presented to the customs department.

Shipping Ports

The importation of vehicles is done through ports like Chittagong or Dhaka. RORO (roll on roll off, roll on) is the most popular shipping method. However, more costly methods of shipment can also be planned based on the client's demand.

Certificate of Title and Registration

Invoice, Register to determine the age

Country of Origin Certificate

Original Bill of Lading (BoL)

Condition Report for Vehicle

Authorization Letter

The Chief Controller for Foreigners needs an import license.

Inspection

[Vehicles](#) imported from Japan require JAAI (Japan Auto Appraisal Institute) inspection and the certification is mandatory.

Rates of import tax

0-40% import tax

15 15% Value-added Tax (VAT).

2.5 percentage of infrastructure development surcharge imposed on imports.

Nationals who return to Bangladesh who has been residing overseas for at least ten years are regarded as "returning nationals", and are entitled to a no-obligation import of one vehicle, provided that the automobile has been maintained for at least two years. The particular conditions of returning citizens as well as their potential contributions to the state building are taken into account.
