Peeling paints or flecks from the start of rust are signs that water is present continuously unless your gutters are very old. This could mean that the gutter fails to transfer water from the roof or that there are cracks or other damages.

Pools of the water sensing mildew around it

Gutters are made to keep water from running toward the foundation of your house. The gutters may not function as intended if you see water pools or mildew close to the foundation.
