#### Prevent cracks

To stop water from entering, freezing, and cracking on driveways, seal concrete yearly and asphalt every few years. Roots from trees and shrubs can produce cracks by pushing up from below. The remedy is to cut back or remove trees close to roadways.

#### Fill cracks

Patch any holes or cracks as soon as they emerge. Before using a gap filler and patching compound, remove loose materials with a masonry chisel and clean up the mess with a brush. Seal the entire driveway once the compound has been dried. When visitors arrive at your house, ensuring your driveway is level, and smooth may also prevent tripping mishaps.

# Minimize water on the driveway

To lessen the likelihood of snow and water seeping through the driveway's surface, leave a two to three-inch strip clear along the driveway's edges. This will serve as a runoff area. Additionally, make sure drains discharge into the yard rather than the driveway.

### Don't salt cement

Surfaces can become penetrated by chemical de-icers and cement salt, leading to fractures. Both need to be fixed. Snow can be removed with a snow blower or shovel, and surfaces can be made less slick by using alternatives like sand, ground coffee, alfalfa meal, or kitty litter rather than salting. Consider misting the ice with sugar beet juice to melt it; this lowers the substance's melting point and is thought to work in -20°F conditions.
